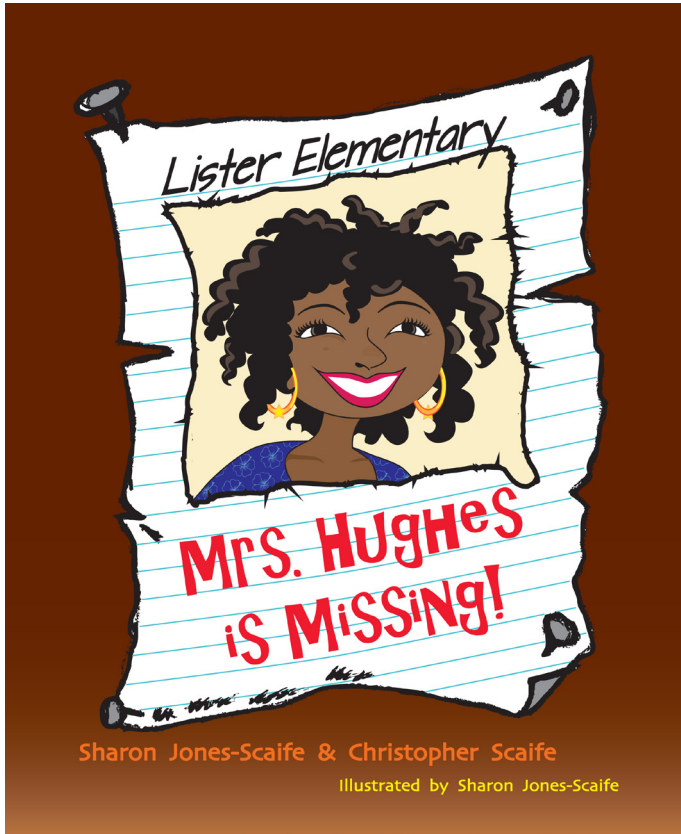


Mrs. Hughes is Missing Jigsaw Puzzle (27 Pieces)

(Intermediate - Grades 2 - 4)



Necessary Supplies:

Printer
Card Stock or Heavy weight paper
Ruler
Scissors
Ziplock Sandwich Bag

Challenge: (Additional Supplies)

X-Acto Knife or Scissors
Pressboard or wood

Necessary Supplies:

Step 1: Print out the picture on the next page on cardstock or heavy weight paper.

Step 2: Using the scissors and the ruler, cut along the perimeter of the puzzle. Note: Children should not use the scissors or X-Acto Knife unattended. Leave the following steps to a parent/grown up.

Step 3: Start to cut out the pieces. Carefully cut them with the scissors. Be careful not to cut yourself.

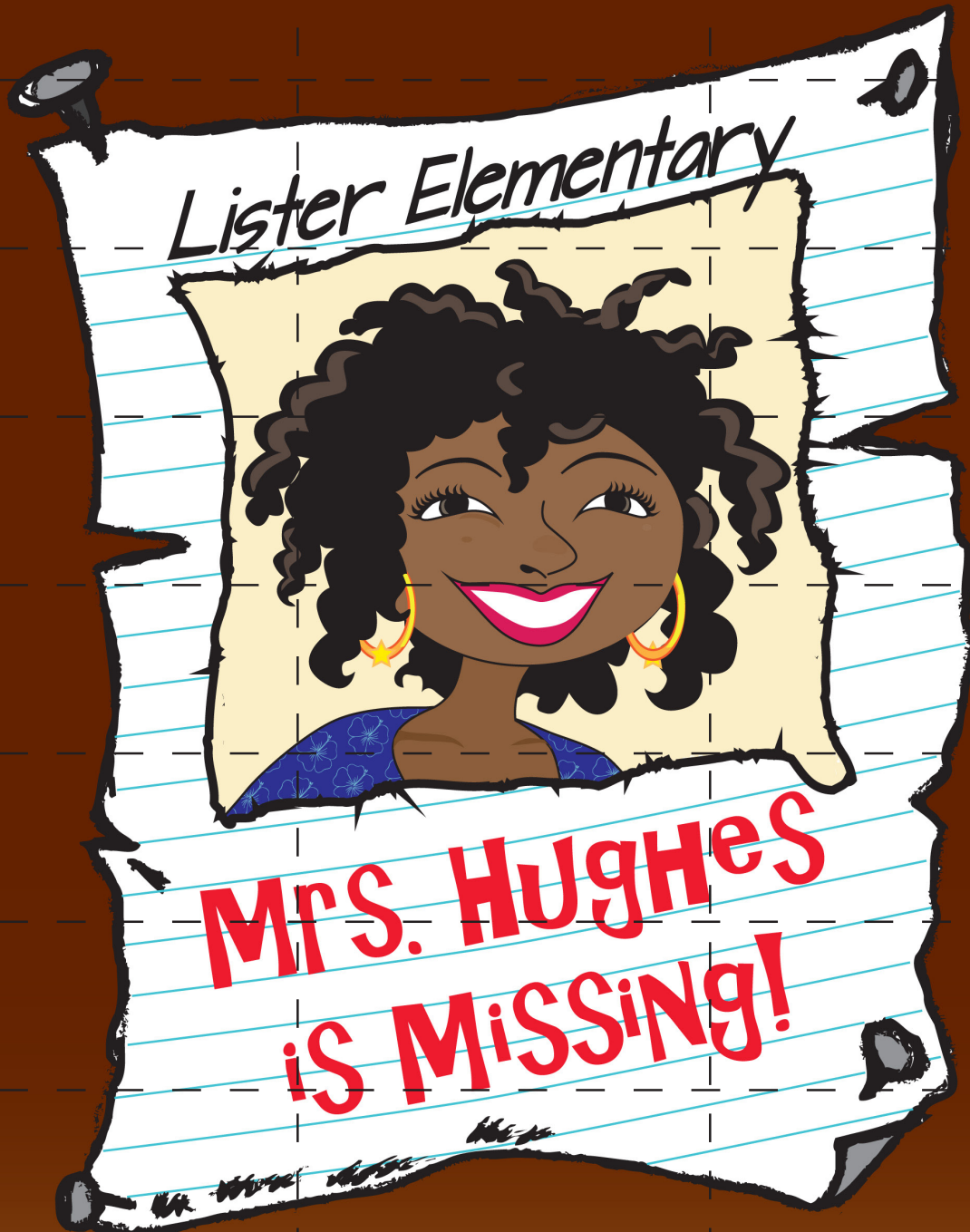
Step 4: Continue to cut out the pieces until they're all separated.

Congratulations! Your puzzle is now complete.

Test out your puzzle by reassembling it. For a more sturdy puzzle and a greater challenge, consider using pressboard or wood.

Use your ziplock bag to store your puzzle pieces and the above picture.
